"DA-TEE-DA, BEE-BOOM-BA..."




Then came a loud *jing-a-ling-ling!*

They scurried into the back door of the shop followed by Nibbles and Sunny.




"I have a tough problem," Mr. Hoppingood said.

"But now they are snuffling and sneezing something awful."




DA-TEE-DA, BEE-BOOM-BA...

"Oh my," said Mimi.


"Let us think about this.
