




QUICK START




Open the hook and loop fastener on the elephant's back. Turn My Buddy™ on by choosing a volume preference.




Choose a stage. Then, close the fastener on the elephant's back.

- TODDLER: 18+ months
- PRESCHOOL: 24+ months




Press the left ear to switch between learning mode and game mode.

NOTE: After playing one game, the elephant will switch back to learning mode.



Press the right ear to put it in sleep mode.



IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Wipe clean with a damp cloth.
- Do not immerse in water.

- Use only size "AAA" (LR03) alkaline batteries (3 required).
- Charging of rechargeable batteries should only be done under adult supervision.





BATTERY INSTALLATION AND GETTING STARTED


The batteries included in your My Buddy™ are for in-store demonstration. Before beginning, an adult must install fresh alkaline batteries. Here's how:


- Open the hook and loop fastener on the elephant's back to locate the battery compartment.
- Using a Phillips screwdriver (not included), remove the screw and battery compartment cover.
- 3. Install three (3) fresh 1.5V AAA (LR03) alkaline batteries (not included) making sure the (+) and (-) ends face the proper direction as indicated inside the battery compartment.
- 4. Replace the compartment cover and tighten the screw.

Make sure the heart button is in position with the heart on the tummy when replacing.



Turn My Buddy™ on by choosing a volume preference.





Choose a stage. Then, close the fastener on the elephant's back.

- INFANT: 6+ months
- TODDLER: 18+ months
- PRESCHOOL: 24+ months

LEARNING MODE

Learn the alphabet, numbers, musical instruments and animals sounds by pressing on its hands and feet.

Play one of four games available.

- Tickle your elephant to hear it laugh.
- Create music when pressing its hands and feet.
- Learn to follow directions with the help of your elephant.
- Interact with your elephant by playing Lala/Buddy says.

After My Buddy™ has finished playing a game, it will go back to learning mode.

SLEEP MODE


When it is time for your elephant to take a nap, press on the right ear.

- I'm feeling sleepy.
 - Time for a nap.
 - A big elephant needs a big nap.

The elephant will go into sleep mode after two minutes of not playing.

Press any hand, foot or left ear to wake it up again.

- Oh, hello.
- •Oh! I'm so excited to play with you.
- It's good to see you.
- I'm so happy to see you.



ABC

INFANT: Learn letters A-C. TODDLER: Learn the alphabet. PRESCHOOL: Learn the letter and a word that starts with each letter.

TICKLE FEATURE

Press to make My Buddy™ laugh.

- That tickles my tummy.
- · That feels silly.
- That's my tummy.
- You're my very best buddy.

MUSIC

INFANT:

Learn sounds of musical instruments.

TODDLER:

Learn sounds and names of musical instruments

PRESCHOOL:

Learn to distinguish the sounds and name the instruments.

ANIMALS

INFANT:

Learn animal sounds. TODDLER:

Learn the animal that makes each sound.

PRESCHOOL:

Learn to distinguish the sounds and name the animals.

My Buddy[™] will speak.

P My Buddy™ will sing or play music.

TICKLE FEATURE

The tickle sensor is located above the heart. Press it to hear your elephant go from a giggle to a silly laugh.

HEART FEATURE

Press the heart to hear one of the songs listed below. In preschool mode, the music will pause so your child can sing along.

IF YOU'RE HAPPY AND YOU KNOW IT

If you're happy and you know it (pause).

You sing this part! (Clap your hands.)

If you're happy and you know it (pause).

Your turn! (Clap your hands.)

If you're happy and you know it, then your face will surely show it.

Ready to sing? (If you're happy and you know it, clap your hands.)

HEAD, SHOULDERS, KNEES AND TOES

Head, shoulders, knees and toes, knees and toes (pause).

You sing this part! (Head, shoulders, knees and toes, knees and toes.)

And eyes and ears and mouth and nose (pause).

Your turn! (Head, shoulders, knees and toes, knees and toes.)

OLD MACDONALD HAD A FARM

Old MacDonald had a farm (pause).

Now you sing! (*E-I-E-I-O*.)

And on his farm he had some chicks (pause).

Ready? (*E-I-E-I-O*.)

With a chick chick here and a chick chick there (pause).

Your turn! (Here a chick, there a chick, everywhere a chick chick.)

Old MacDonald had a farm (pause).

One more time! (E-I-E-I-O.)

ITSY-BITYSY SPIDER

The itsy-bitsy spider (pause).

Now you sing! (*Climbed up the water spout.*)

Down came the rain (pause).

Your turn! (*And washed the spider out.*)

Out came the sun (pause).

Ready? (And dried up all the rain.)

And the itsy-bitsy spider (pause).

One more time! (Climbed up the spout again.)

TWINKLE, TWINKLE, LITTLE STAR

Twinkle, twinkle, little star (pause). Sing with me! (How I wonder what you are.)

Up above the world so high (pause).

Your turn! (Like a diamond in the sky.)

Twinkle, twinkle, little star (pause).

One more time! (*How I wonder what you are.*)

Press the left ear and your elephant will start one of these four games.

- Let's play a game!
 - · Wanna play a game with me?
 - Let's Play!

MUSIC MAKER

This game is available in infant mode, toddler mode and preschool mode.

My Buddy[™] will prompt a command and then play the melody of a song either with the piano or saxophone.

- Squeeze my hand to make music!
 - Squeeze my hand to play a song!
 - Squeeze my foot to hear another instrument!
- Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star
 - Old MacDonald Had a Farm
 - If You're Happy and You Know It

LAUGHTER BUILDER

This game is available in infant mode, toddler mode and preschool mode.

My Buddy[™] will prompt a command and then start giggling.

- Squeeze my paw!
 - · Squeeze my foot!
 - Tickle my tummy!

It will start with a short giggle and elevate to a bigger laugh. It will end with one of four phrases.

- Whew! That was fun.
 - · Laughing feels so good.
 - That was silly.
 - You're an elephant's best friend.

FOLLOWING DIRECTIONS

This game is available in toddler mode and preschool mode.

My Buddy[™] will ask a questions and give a response if the answer is right or wrong.

- Can you squeeze my hand?
 - Can you squeeze my foot?
 - Can you tickle my tummy?

If correct, it will say one of these phrases.

- Woohoo! You did it. That makes me so happy.
 - Yay! You did it. Superb job!
 - That was fun.
 - · You've done a mammoth job.
 - •That's music to my big ears.
- That's right! Oh yay! You did it! Hooray!

If incorrect, it will say one of these phrases.

- Oh! That's my foot.
 - That's my tummy.
 - · Oops! That's my hand.

Play along with My Buddy[™] when he asks:

- Can you tickle your tummy?
 - Can you touch your nose?
 - Can you pat your head?
 - Can you clap your hands?
 - Can you spin around?
 - Can you shake your trunk?
 - Can you wag your tail?

 - Can you stomp your feet?

LALA/BUDDY SAYS

This game is available in preschool mode.

My Buddy[™] will begin by saying, "Lala says" or "Buddy says" and then prompt a command.

- Squeeze my hand!
 - Squeeze my foot!
 - Tickle my tummy!
 - Squeeze my hand two times!
 - Squeeze my foot two times!
 - Tickle my tummy two times!
 - · Squeeze my hand three times!
 - Squeeze my foot three times!
 - Tickle my tummy three times!

If correct, it will say one of these phrases.

- · Woohoo! You did it. That makes me so happy.
 - Yay! You did it. Superb job!
 - That was fun.
 - · You've done a mammoth job.
- That's music to my big ears.
- That's right! Oh yay! You did it! Hooray!

If incorrect, it will say one of these phrases.

- Oops! I didn't say, "Lala says."
 - Oops! I didn't say, "Buddy says."
 - Whoops!
 - Oopsies!
 - Let's try again!
 - Let's try another one!

LEARNING MODE

Press the left ear and you can begin learning the alphabet, numbers, musical instruments and animals sounds.

- Learning is so much fun. Let's learn together!
- I love learning with you.
- · Learning with you makes me feel so happy.
- I can't wait to learn with you. And once an elephant learns, he never forgets.

INFANT 6+ MONTHS



Press the left hand to start learning numbers. Continue pressing the hand to go to the next number. After it finishes counting, it will sing.

- One! Two! Three!
- One, two, three! It's fun to count with me!

Press the left foot to start learning instruments.

Violin, piano, banjo, xylophone, trumpet,

guitar, saxophone, ukulele, drum, flute.

See the list below for all the instruments.

Continue to press it to go to the next instrument.



Press the right hand to start learning the alphabet. Continue to press it to go to the next letter. It will sing once it is done.

- ♠ A! B! C!
- A. B. C! It's fun for you and me!



Press the right foot to learn animal sounds. Continue to press it to go to the next animal. See the list below for all the animal sounds.

 Moo!, Neigh!, Ribbit!, Elephant's trunk's trumpet!, Baa!, Oink, oink!, Woof, woof!, Quack, quack!, Meow!, Bok, bok, bok!



TODDLER 18+ MONTHS

Press the left hand to start learning numbers. Continue to press it to go to the next number. It will sing once it is done.

Let's count together!

One! Two! Three! Four! Five! Six! Seven! Eight! Nine! Ten!

One, two, buckle my shoe. Three, four, open the door. Five, six, pick up sticks. Seven, eight, lay them straight. Nine, ten, a big fat hen.



Press the right hand to start learning the alphabet. Continue to press it to go to the next letter. It will sing the Alphabet Song once it is

Let's learn the alphabet!

A! B! C! D! E! F! G! H! I! J! K! L! M! N! O! P! O! R! S! T! U! V! W! X! Y! Z!

→ My Buddy™ sings the Alphabet Song.



By pressing the left foot, My Buddy™ will say the instrument and then play the melody. Continue to press it to go to the next instrument.

- Let's learn about musical instruments!
- Violin, piano, banjo, xylophone, trumpet, guitar, saxophone, ukulele, drum, flute.



By pressing the right foot, My Buddy™ will say the animal and then mimic its sound. Continue to press it to go to the next animal.

Cows go moo.
 Horses go neigh.
 Frogs go ribbit, ribbit.
 Elephants go (trunk's trumpet).
 Sheep go baa.
 Pigs go oink, oink.
 Dogs go woof, woof.
 Ducks go quack, quack.
 Cats go meow.
 Chickens go bok, bok, bok.





Press the left hand to hear your elephant count animal sounds. Continue to press it to go to the next number.

- (Moo) One cow!
 (Neigh x2) Two horses!
 (Ribbit x3) Three frogs!
 (Trunk's trumpet x4) Four elephants!
 (Baa x5) Five sheep!
 (Oink x6) Six pigs!
 (Woof x7) Seven puppies!
 (Quack x8) Eight ducks!
 (Meow x9) Nine kittens!
 (Bok x10) Ten chickens!
- I'm so glad we counted to ten! Press my hand to do it again.

Press the right hand to hear a letter and a word that starts with that letter. Continue to press it to go to the next letter and word.

- A is for apple!B is for balloon!C is for cat!
 - D is for duck!

E is for elephant! That's me! (Giggles)

F is for fish! (Bubbles)

G is for goose! (Honk, honk)

H is for horse! (Neigh)

I is for ice cream!

J is for juice!

K is for kangaroo! (Boing, boing)

L is for lion!

M is for monkey!

N is for nap! (Shhhh!)

O is for owl

P is for panda!

Q is for (whisper) quiet!

R is for rabbit!

S is for sailboat!

T is for trunk! See my big trunk?

(Trunk's trumpet)

U is for umbrella! (Rain)

V is for violin! (Violin plays)

W is for whale! (Whale song)

X is for xylophone! (Xylophone plays)

Y is for yogurt!

Z is for zebra!

• Wasn't that fun? The alphabet's done.



Press the left foot and your elephant will ask a question, play an instrument's melody, pause and name that instrument. Continue to press it to go to the next instrument.

- What instrument sounds like this? Which instrument makes this sound? Which instrument is this?
- ◆ Violin, piano, banjo, xylophone, trumpet, guitar, saxophone, ukulele, drum, flute.



Press the right foot and your elephant will ask a question, pause and mimic an animal sound. Continue to press it to go to the next animal.

What sound does a cow make? Moo. What sound does a horse make? Neigh. What sound does a frog make? Ribbit, ribbit. What sound does an elephant make? Trunk's trumpet.

What sound does a sheep make? Baa.
What sound does a pig make? Oink, oink.
What sound does a dog make? Woof, woof.
What sound does a duck make? Quack, quack.
What sound does a cat make? Meow.
What sound does a chicken make? Bok, bok, bok.

IDLE MODE

After 15 seconds of not playing with the elephant, it will go in idle mode. It will say one of the following phrases or sing a song.

- When I say peeka, you say boo! (Pause) Peeka!
- Wanna play?
- Will you play with me?
- I can't wait to play with you.

- Sing into my ears if you can find them!
- Squeeze my tummy!
- Squeeze my ear and let's play!

PAT-A-CAKE

Pat-a-cake, pat-a-cake, me and you. Baking a cake is fun to do. Pat it, roll it, and mark it with an "E." Put it in the oven for you and me.

BEST FRIEND

You're my best friend. I love you. Let's be best friends, Just me and you!

FOOT SONG

I have two feet. A left and a right. Now tickle my toes! Ha! Ha! That's right.

EAR SONG

We have two ears. Count one and two. Now squeeze my big ears. You can hear me too!

PEEK-A-BOO

Peek-a-boo! Where are you? Look for me, and I'll look for you too!

HIDE AND SEEK

Hide and seek, Is fun to play! Can we play it every day?

SING ALONG SONG

I love to sing. Now sing with me. Let's sing a silly song, About elephants up a tree!

PANDA SONG

No other elephant, Can do what I do! I love to learn, Alona with you!

COLOR SONG

Colors are fun. Red, pink, blue.

What's your favorite color? What color is your shoe?

TUMMY SONG

When you scratch my tummy, I giggle away.
Tickle my tummy,
'Cause I love to play!

BEAR HUG SONG

Give an elephant a hug. Don't squeeze too tight. Elephants love hugs. Ooh! That feels just right!

PAW SONG

Numbers and letters, And singing songs. Now tickle my feet, And we'll have fun.

BAMBOO SONG

I love to chew grass, And the leaves from the trees. An elephant's trunk, can reach all of these.

◆ Wasn't that fun?
